The college has collaborated with 'Jagruti'- waste paper recycling services for effective waste paper management. For the collection of paper waste, 'Jagruti' staff visited the college on September 27, 2021 and collected 1896.04 kg of waste paper. In return, 'Jagruti' provided 30 reams. of A4 paper (70 gsm) and certificate of recycling to the college. The biodegradable waste (kitchen waste, left-over food, gardening waste etc.) of the college is converted to manure using in-house compost pit. At present, 350-400 kg (approx.) compost has been formed, which will be used as manure for gardening purpose. Also, the WMC and ENACTUS (Convenor- Dr Sonia Dhingra) jointly came together to make packets of manure (5 kg each) formed in the compost pits and sell the packets to the teaching & non-teaching staff, students and outsiders at highly subsidized rate (Rs 30 per kg). Sum of total Rs 14350.00 (Fourteen Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty only) was given by the scrap dealer. MENTOR-MENTEE REPORT

The college wishes to provide its students with an ideal, stress-free atmosphere, proper guidance, and counselling (academic as well as non-academic), the college has been following a mentor-mentee practice for the last few years. We have divided the students of the college into small groups and each group is allotted a member from the teaching faculty as MENTOR. Under the system, the information of mentor-mentee is displayed on the college website through two notices, one notice for the mentors along with the department wise teacher list was attached with it, in which in front of the teacher's name their mentees class and roll numbers were given and another notice for the students along with the class wise list of students was attached, in which their mentor name was provided. The college also sent the email to the entire students, which contain the name of their mentor name and email id. The information of mentees, their phone number, and email ids are shared with the entire teachers through email. The list of mentees with their phone no. and mail ids for respective mentors is available on the college portal. So that mentor-mentee can meet each other frequently. If a girl student hesitates to share her problem with the male mentor, then she can share her problem with any female mentor. The MENTOR-MENTEE ratio for the session 2021-22 is 40.

Feedback Committee

P.G.D.A.V. College (Eve.) is taking feedback from the students for both semesters (even and odd) since the 2015 - 2016 session. After taking feedback through pen paper for one semester the whole process was shifted online. First online feedback was taken for odd

We also try to improve the feedback form based on changes in the college and other factors.
